

# 2010 4-H Scholarships

The following scholarships are available to 4-H members through MB 4-H Council

- No interviews required. Paper adjudication only.
- Members are not eligible to win the same scholarship twice.
- Applicants can receive only one of the scholarships listed on this application in the same year.
- Incomplete applications (i.e. name missing from pages, late postmarked, or missing criteria) will be disqualified.

**Applications MUST be postmarked to the Brandon Office no later than Thursday, March 18, 2010.**

*What grading system is used by Manitoba 4-H Council to select the scholarship winners?*

(This criteria applies to the Manitoba 4-H Council, Canadian Wheat Board, Western Producer and Bayer Crop Science Scholarships only.)

4-H involvement 20%, Essay (if applicable) 25%, Extra Curricular Participation 15%, School Grades 15%, Personal Information 10%, References 5%, Career Plans 5%, Employment 5%

## ➔ CANADIAN WHEAT BOARD SCHOLARSHIP

One \$1,000 award to be used towards obtaining a degree in the faculties of Agricultural and Food Sciences or Human Ecology.

### Eligibility

- must be 16 years of age as of January 1, 2010.
- must have been a 4-H member for at least two years and have been registered in 4-H within the last two years (2008/2009 club year or later)

## ➔ WESTERN PRODUCER SCHOLARSHIP

One \$1,000 award to a student of a Diploma or Degree program related to agriculture, agribusiness or the rural economy of Manitoba at any officially recognized Canadian Post Secondary Institution

- Must be at least 16 years of age as of January 1, 2010.
- Must have been registered as a Manitoba 4-H member for at least 3 years and have been registered as a member within the last 3 years. (2007/2008 or later).

## ➔ BAYER CROPSCIENCE 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

One \$500 award for 4-H members used toward either a degree or diploma in Agriculture, Agribusiness or Sciences.

### Eligibility

- must be 16 years of age as of January 1, 2010.
- must have been a 4-H member for at least two years and have been registered in 4-H within the last two years (2008/2009 or later).

## ➔ MANITOBA 4-H COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIPS

Five \$1,000 awards towards post-secondary education. These scholarships are made possible from funds generated from the MB 4-H Endowment Fund Foundation.

### Eligibility

- must be 16 years of age as of January 1, 2010.
- must have been a 4-H member for at least two years.
- Must achieve in the year applying ('09/'10).
- must submit a 250-500 word essay on one of the following topics:
  1. *Quality People: How will the character traits developed by the 4-H program help me in my future?*
  2. *Quality Experiences: What quality experiences in the 4-H program have kept me involved in 4-H projects?*
  3. *Quality Projects: What makes a quality 4-H program?*

  - Reference must be current; dated within the past four months.
- b) Education/Career – Please fill out this section on a separate sheet.
  - What level of education are you currently taking? Include grade and/or year.
  - What post-secondary educational institution and specific program have you applied to, do you plan to attend or are attending?
  - Education Records – Please submit the transcript / statement of marks or photocopy of same, from S1 (grade 9) to the current year. Keep in mind that NO late items will be accepted.
