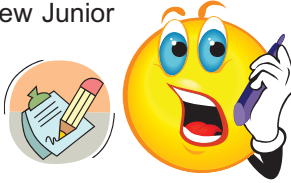


# Hello South Parkland 4-H Families Welcome to the 2009-2010 4-H Year

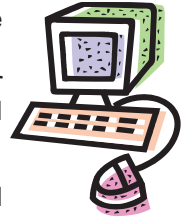
